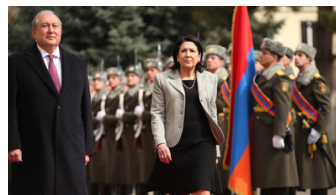




President Salome Zourabichvili Paid an Official Visit to Armenia

- The Parliaments of various countries, included Norway, Israel, France, Great Britain, Spain, Finland, Hungary, Armenia, Kuwait, Poland, Turkey and Romania congratulated Georgia and underlined that the first Parliament of Georgia has created the excellent

example of democracy and thus, gave the foundation to the free and democratic Republic of Georgia.
