- Within the frames of his visit Minister Zalkaliani held meetings with the U.S. Under Secretary of State for Arms Control and International Security Andrea Thompson, Assistant Secretary of State for European and Eurasian Affairs Wess Mitchell, Advisor to the U.S. President for European Affairs Dr. Fiona Hill, U.S. Special Envoy for Venezuela Elliott Abrams, U.S. Special Representative for Afghanistan Reconciliation Zalmay Khalilzad and with U.S. Congressmen and Senators. Minister Zalkaliani also held a meeting with the Representative of Venezuela's legitimate Government to the U.S., Carlos Vecchio.



- During Minister Zalkaliani's visit, Congressman Rooney re-introduced a resolution expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the territories of Abkhazia and South Ossetia are part of the sovereign state of Georgia and condemning the decision by the Syrian Arab Republic to recognize these territories as independent of Georgia. The Overseas Private Investment Corporation (OPIC) Allocates 50 Million Dollars in Georgian Marine Terminal

In accordance with the agreement, the US-based OPIC will allocate 50 Million Dollars to finance construction of a new marine terminal in Poti.
