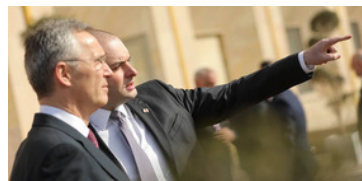




### NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg Visited Georgia

25.03.2019 TBILISI

- During his visit to Georgia, Jens Stoltenberg held meetings with President Salome Zourabichvili, Prime Minister Mamuka Bakhtadze, Speaker of the Parliament Irakli Kobakhidze and members of the Parliament. Stoltenberg visited Joint Training and Evaluation Centre and observed the NATO-Georgia Exercise that brought together up to 350 participants from 24 NATO and partner countries.
- **Discussed:** The process of Georgia's NATO membership, progress made by the country towards its Euro-Atlantic



integration, issues related to Black Sea security, situation in Georgia's occupied regions and Georgia's significant role in strengthening the common Euro-Atlantic security.

• **“NATO allies have clearly stated that Georgia will become a member of the Alliance and we are supporting Georgia to meet our standards, to continue to reform, and to be ready to join.... Georgia is one of NATO's closest partners, working with the Alliance on security in the Black Sea region”** - Jens Stoltenberg said. **MORE**

### The Speaker of the Parliament Irakli Kobakhidze Paid a Visit to Serbia

27-30.03.2019 BELGRADE

- Within the frames of his visit Speaker Kobakhidze held meetings with the President, Aleksandar Vučić, Prime Minister Ana Brnabić, President of the National Assembly Maja Gojkovic and the Patriarch Irinej.
- **Discussed:** Enhancement of economic and political cooperation, intensification of inter-parliamentary relations, direct flights between the countries to further facilitate people-to-people relations and opening of Serbia's diplomatic representation in Georgia.
- During the visit Speaker Kobakhidze officially opened the Consulate of Georgia in Serbia, he also delivered a speech in the National Assembly of Serbia, participated in Georgia-Serbia Business Forum and attended the official reception dedicated to the 100th Anniversary of Georgian Parliamentarism.
- As part of the visit, Agreement on Partnership between the parliaments of Georgia and Serbia, as well as Memorandum of Cooperation between the Agency “Produce in Georgia” and Serbian Development Agency were signed. **MORE**

- During the visit to NATO HQ, Minister Zalkaliani participated in the NATO-Georgia Commission Meeting at the permanent representatives' level, where NATO-Georgia cooperation on Black Sea Security was discussed. NATO permanent representatives reaffirmed that Georgia has all practical tools to prepare for membership, highly appraised Georgia's progress in the implementation of the ANP and SNGP, as well as acknowledged Georgia's impressive democratic, political and economic reforms agenda.
- Minister David Zalkaliani also met with NATO Deputy Secretary General Rose Gottemoeller and representatives of the Georgian Diaspora.
- **Discussed:** NATO-Georgia cooperation on Black Sea security, Georgia's NATO integration process and situation in Georgia's occupied regions of Abkhazia and Tskhinvali. **MORE**
